Latest Inspiration

St. Ann History

St. Ann's celebrated 183 years as a parish this month!

Established in 1841, St. Ann Parish is the oldest remaining of several parishes established in Jennings County around the same time. Two other churches were also built around 1841: the former St. Patrick Church in Scipio, and St. Catherine Church, near the current St. Joseph Church.

In 1850, German members of St. Catherine split off to start a new parish nearby, originally known as St. James but what is now the current St. Joseph Parish. St. Catherine Church remained as a mission parish of St. Ann until around 1872, and the cemetery still remains. St. Patrick in Scipio lasted until 1958, when it merged with St. Mary in North Vernon. Its cemetery also remains.
