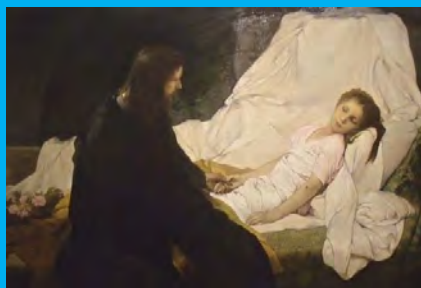

**REQUIRED BAPTISM CLASS**

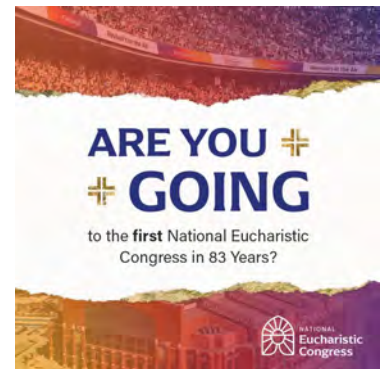
