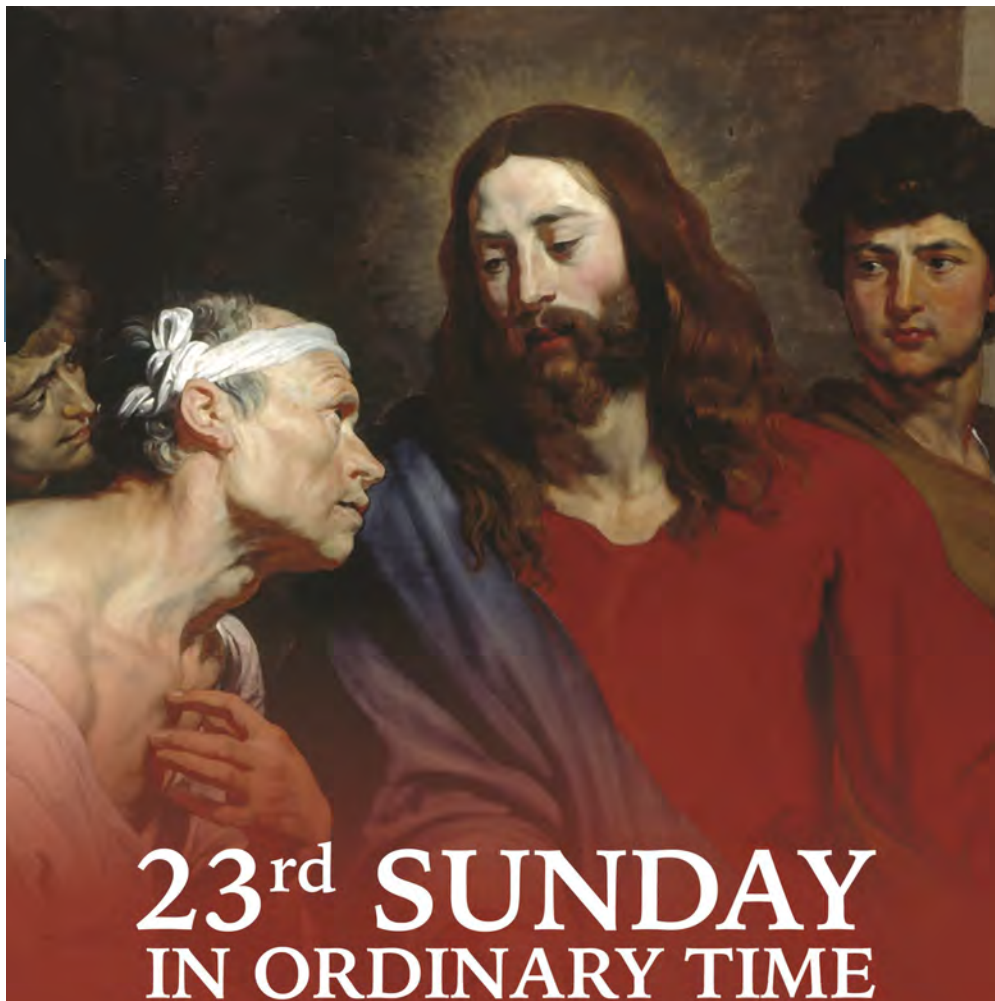

COUNTRY STORE ITEMS NEEDED FOR SJ BAZAAR

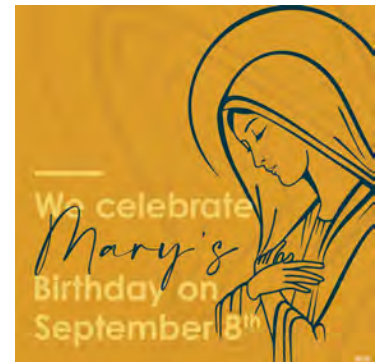
