


Praying the rosary honors our Blessed Mother for the protection She gives us and Her powerful intercession to the prayers of the faithful. Please join us at the following:

THE FISCAL YEAR REPORT IS AS FOLLOWS:

- *13,500 volunteer hours allowed us to assist people in Jennings County.
- *Food Insecurity: \$26,000 supporting 1,400 individuals
- *Utility Assistance/Cut-Off Avoidance: \$62,000 supporting 800 individuals
- *Housing Assistance/Eviction Avoidance: \$43,000 supporting 350 individuals.
- *Essential Clothing: \$4,800 supporting 450 individual.
- *Personal Care/Hygiene: \$1,000 supporting 350 individuals.
