

Keep Reading the rest of this newsletter for a story of one family's hope in joy after a fire destroyed their home, resources and more! From a very young age, Philip was known for being cheerful and obedient. He was affectionately referred to as "good little Phil." He received his early teachings from friars at the Dominican monastery in Florence, San Marco.

He was born in July 21, 1515 and lived in the time of the Renaissance. He was also known for his Oratory for young people. The youth would gather to read and discuss Sacred Scripture, to pray spontaneously, and present on a theme about Christian doctrine, the virtues and the lives of the saints.

Rome, Sweet Rome!






Father Byrd's pilgrimage to

Their home burned to the ground in northern Los Angeles County with the current wildfire tragedies. The adult children and spouses gathered with their parents as Peter started them off in the 12th century Latin hymn to Mary that has been taught to the family for generations.
