



The beauty of using Candlemas candles at someone's deathbed

We just celebrated Candlemas on Feb. 2! John Paul II, <u>during a homily in 1998</u>, mentioned a tradition during surrounding these candles that was connected to a person's deathbed:

"Even more eloquent is the custom of putting the candle blessed on this day in the hands of a Christian on his deathbed, that it may illumine his last steps on the way to eternity.

This practice is meant to show that, by following the light of faith, the dying person is waiting to enter the eternal dwelling place, where there is no longer "need of light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light" (Rev: 22:5).
